


Change the sensor panel on Sense hoods



Start by cutting the power to the kitchen hood.

Changing the panel while the hood is connected to power will damage the unit.



At the end of the panel, near the light source, there's a small opening. Use a flat screw driver to unhook the panel.



The panel will then usually come loose with slight force of hand, or you can loosen the other side with a flat screw driver as well.



The sensor panel should now be free from the hood.




Carefully unplug the flat cable connecting the hood to the Sense unit.



Reconnect the flat cable to the new sensor panel.



Make sure the flat cable does not bend or fold when replacing the new sensor panel into the kitchen hood.



Turn the power back on to restart the kitchen hood.
